- 3. Our students in grades 3 5 will participate in the PSSA exams in late April / early May. Math exams will be on May 3 and 4. Our fourth grade students will also have science exams on May 5. Additional information will be shared, but these dates are being shared now for planning purposes. Here is some additional information about this year's testing.

We will be conducting kindergarten readiness screenings in late May. Stay tuned for additional information to be shared before that time.

On *Tuesday, May 10*, teachers will complete the spring universal screening behavior tool, the *Student Risk Screening Scale for Internalizing and Externalizing Behaviors (SRSS-IE)*, for students in their class. We will use this information to identify students who may be at risk and would benefit from additional school support and interventions. Parents/Guardians of those students who score at risk will be contacted by the school.
